To take part in this spring program, simply **find two friends** the same age who like to play hockey, **form a team** consisting of three (3) players, **register** by turning in this form & payment to the front office or by calling (253) 850-2400 ext. 108 & **come** to KVIC each Monday evening to **play**. (Individual registrations are welcome and will be placed on a team. Goalies are welcome to register as individuals.) Registrations are now being accepted and space will be limited, so please sign up early. Registration is on a **first-come, first-served basis** per the following guidelines:

We will register up to eighteen (18) teams from the Beginner (LTP) and Mite Rec. levels – (ages 4-8 years old) up to the Bantam Rec. level (ages 13-14 years old).

A team's age will be defined by the relative-ages of two of its three members, with all decisions regarding team placement made by the KVIC and considered final. **There are no slapshots or bodychecks**, and all players are to be fully-equipped according to USA Hockey rules. If necessary, substitutions are to be arranged by the team and the KVIC must be notified in advance of the involved session.

Each session will provide three (3), twenty-five minute games, resulting in approx. 40 minutes of actual playing time. (Roughly the same ice time as in three regular season games.)

To the parents: it is the primary intent of this program to provide an opportunity for the kids to organize & manage themselves in a more relaxed, game-like setting than in a typical team atmosphere. Win or lose, the onus is on the players to simply play. In short, outside of providing a referee (i.e. adult-supervision), ice-time, and an opponent, there will be zero coaching provided.
