



KVHA News – Caleb Chaloner Tallies Ten Points in Two Consecutive Games

Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent, WA. Tuesday, January 12, 2016 – Kent Valley's Caleb Chaloner tallied ten points over two consecutive games in December to come within one point of the KVHA record of eleven points over two games. By doing so, Chaloner gets honorable mention in the KVHA Record Book under the category of Most Points in Two Consecutive Games. Tyler Jennings (07/08 – 13/14) holds the current record of 11 points set back on January 18th and 19th, 2014. The record book now reads as follows:

11 – 01/18 & 01/19/2014 Tyler Jennings, 01/18/14 Kent Valley Midget Tier-II Selects 15 vs. Tacoma Midget Tier-II Rockets 0 and 01/19/14 Kent Valley Midget Tier-II Selects 12 vs. Tacoma Midget Tier-II Rockets 0. On 01/18 Jennings had 2 assists in the first period, 1 in the second period and 2 in the third period. All five of Jennings' assists were first assists. On 01/19 Jennings had 1 assist in the first period, 2 in the second period and 2 in the third period. Jennings also scored a goal in the third period for a total of 6 points in the game and 11 points in two consecutive games.

10 – 12/19 & 12/20/2015 Caleb Chaloner, Kent Valley PeeWee Tornados 6 vs. Washington Wild 12U 1 and 12/20/2015 Kent Valley PeeWee Tornados 8 vs. Kent Valley Squirt "B" Selects 0. On 12/19 Chaloner had 2 goals in the first period, 1 in the second period and 1 in the third period plus an assist in the third period for 5 points. On 12/20 Chaloner had 2 goals in the first period, 1 in the second period and 1 in the third period plus an assist in the third period for 5 points, making a total of 10 points over two consecutive games.

So you think it was cold?

We all made a big deal out of the below zero temperatures at the Seahawks' playoff game in Minnesota last weekend. I was so acclimated to the cold temperatures during the game that when I went outside after the game I expected the same freezing temperatures.

Kent Valley's Les Grauer (Regina, SK) and Danny Lorenz (Edmonton, AB) both commented about freezing temperatures during outdoor hockey games they played in their youth. Lorenz said games were called off only when the temperature dropped below -23 Celsius (or -10 Fahrenheit). Grauer didn't recall a limit for cancelling a hockey game because of low temperatures. "We just played," he said.

The average monthly low temperatures in Regina from October through March (comparable to our KVHA hockey season) run -1.7, -10.5, -19, -21.1, -18.5 and -11.6. It warms up in April to an average low of -2.4. Edmonton is only slightly warmer. Now that's cold...
