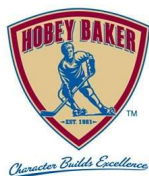




KVHA News – Dylan Gambrell Nominated for 2018 Hobey Baker Memorial Award

Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent, WA., Friday, January 19, 2018 – Former Kent Valley player Dylan Gambrell has been nominated for the 2018 Hobey Baker Memorial Award, the most coveted award in collegiate hockey, given annually to the country's top NCAA men's ice hockey player. KVHA encourages everyone to visit the Hobey Baker Facebook page and cast a vote for Dylan. Dylan played six seasons for Kent Valley beginning with the Mite Tornadoes in 2003/2004 through the PeeWee WC/KV Elite for the 2008/2009 season. Gambrell currently plays for the University of Denver and is ranked second in scoring with 9 goals and 18 assists for 27 points over 22 games.



College hockey fans can cast their vote here from the field of 74 nominees for the 2018 Hobey Baker Award. Nominated players were submitted by the athletic departments of the Division I men's hockey schools with a maximum of three candidates from any one school.

Price Waterhouse Coopers tabulates the votes and the top 10 candidates are announced. The final award will be announced in May 2018.

The Hobey Baker Award was named for hockey legend and World War I veteran Hobey Baker. Universally recognized as the best amateur player in the United States, Baker was the ultimate gentleman sportsman, always playing the game with courage, honor, and humility. Winners are chosen not for raw skill or stats or character alone, though those are important. They are selected for everything they do.

Candidates must:

- Exhibit strength and character, both on and off the ice
- Contribute to the integrity of the team
- Display outstanding skills in all phases of the game
- Show scholastic achievement and sportsmanship

A Word or Two About Score Sheets...

Score sheets are due in the KVHA office on the Monday following the weekend games, Tuesday if a tournament game was played on Monday.

Coaches: Please make sure the scoring is legible and complete, including assists and goalie stats (shots and saves.) Power play goals should be noted as PP, short handed goals as SH and empty net goals as EN. Make sure you identify the goalie(s).

Kent Valley 10U Hurricanes Slip Past SnoKing 10U Van Zelm 6 to 5 at SnoKing

Castle Ice Arena, Renton, WA. January 6, 2017 – The two teams played the first half even at 2 and 2 with Kent Valley getting goals from Nathaniel Beregovoy and Jaxson Trichak. The Hurricanes took a quick lead early in the second half on George Whitney's first goal of the game. SnoKing countered to tie the game at 3-all a few minutes later. SnoKing got their first lead of the game, 4 to 3, with a goal with 13:23 remaining to play. Jaxson Trichak tied the game at 4-all with his goal with 10:14 remaining. SnoKing persisted with a strong offensive effort that paid off with a goal giving them a 5-4 lead with 6:35 to play. George Whitney wasn't about to let the SnoKing lead stand. Besides, he had a Hat Trick to complete before heading back to Kent. Whitney and his teammates put together a strong

offense of their own giving Whitney the opportunity to tie the game with 5:41 remaining. Whitney scored the game-winner less than a minute later with 4:51 left to play giving the Hurricanes a 6 to 5 lead that lasted to the final buzzer. Way to go George! Congratulations to the Hurricanes!

SnoKing 10U Lehman Jet Past Kent Valley 10U Tornadoes 18 to 7 as Sun Establishes New KVHA Record

Castle Ice Arena, Renton, WA. January 6, 2017 – True to their name, the SnoKing 10U Lehman “Jets” turned on their afterburners and blew past the Kent Valley 10U Tornadoes 18 to 7 at Castle Ice Arena. The Tornadoes’ Edward Sun did his best to shut down the Jets by scoring six goals in the first half and setting a new KVHA record for Most Goals in One Period (6). Sun held the previous record of five goals in one period set back on November 19, 2017. Delilah Lindsey scored the Tornadoes’ only goal in the second half.

Michael Poliakov linked up Jake Ferguson to score the Selects second goal of the game near the end of the second period. Poliakov’s goal was credited as

the game-winning goal. Seattle Jr. got on the scoreboard midway through the third period to cut the Selects' lead to one goal (2 to 1.) Andrew Deskin scored an insurance goal with 5:52 remaining to play with an assist from Ferguson, giving the Selects a 3 to 1 win. Benjamin Douglass led all scorers for the Selects with 6 goals and 2 assists for 8 points. Lucas Majors was second with 3 goals and 2 assists for 5 points. Brody Belaire and Michael Poliakov each had 4 points, Belaire with 2 goals and 2 assists and Poliakov with 4 assists. Every player on the Selects' roster had at least 1 point during the tournament.

The Selects' goaltenders turned in excellent performances with Tyler Roberts getting a shutout in game four and turning away 32 of 34 shots over three games for a very respectable 94.1% save rate. Blade Taylor earned shutouts, in both games he played in, stopping 35 of 35 shots for a perfect 100% save rate.
