Kent Valley PeeWee Tornadoes Soar over WWFHA Phoenix

Kingsgate Ice Arena, Kent, WA. February 9, 2013 – It took the Kent Valley PeeWee Tornadoes two periods to find a way to get the puck past the Phoenix's Anna Stensland. When the Tornadoes found the chink in Stensland's armor, they exploited it to the fullest. Stensland stopped 19 of 20 shots in the first period, turned away 17 of 18 shots in the second period and stopped 11 of 18 shots in the final period.

The Tornadoes' Lane Eriks scored the first goal of the game and went on to score a Hat Trick plus one for a total of 4 goals and 4 points. The big point getter in this game was Jesse Everson with 2 goal and 3 assists for 5 points. Noah Koester matched Eriks in points with a well balanced offense of 2 goals and 2 assists for 4 points.
