

Kent Valley Rainiers Drop Tournament Opener to Florida Everblades 5 to 7

Amherst Ice Centre, Amherst, NY 7 April, 2010 – The Kent Valley PeeWee Tier-I Rainiers dropped their tournament opening game to the Florida Everblades by a score of 5 to 7 this afternoon. The Everblades scored first on an unassisted goal with 8:31 remaining in the first period. Kent Valley tied it at 1 to 1 in the closing seconds of the first period on a goal by John Anderson from Luke Van Schaack. Florida scored a go-ahead power play goal at 8:25 into the second period. Kent Valley tied the game at 2 apiece on a power play goal by Kailer Yamamoto with an assist from Jake Levin. The Rainiers took the lead two minutes later when McKinley Kempf scored with assists from Yamamoto and Bo Hanson.

Florida scored three unanswered goals, two in the closing minutes of the second period and one to open the third period to regain the lead and bump the score to 5 to 3 in their favor. Kent Valley trimmed the Florida lead to one goal, making it 5 to 4 with 12:32 remaining in regulation play, as Kailer Yamamoto scored an unassisted goal. Florida's Nick Pastujov scored his second and third goals of the game with 5:09 and 1:17 remaining to play to put his team up 7 to 4. Kent Valley fought back pulling goalie Evan Sarthou for an extra attacker and taking advantage of a power play opportunity in the remaining 1:17 to get within two as Jordan Greenhall scored a power play goal at 14:28 off an assist from McKinley Kempf. Kent Valley was unable to score in the remaining 32 seconds. Final score; Florida Everblades 7 and Kent Valley Rainiers 5.

Next up for the Rainiers is a matchup against the New Jersey Rockets Thursday at 9:15 local time (12:15 EST.) The New Jersey Rockets lost their first game to the Chicago Mission by a score of 1 to 4 earlier today (Wednesday.) Below is the scoring summary:
