



USA Hockey Pacific District Select Camps Coming to Kent Valley Ice Centre

Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent, WA. April 28, 2011 – The “**Best in the West**” will begin walking through the front entrance of Kent Valley Ice Centre this Friday to participate in the first of two Pacific District Select Camps. The Pacific District Select Camps take the best male and female players from across the District as selected by each State Affiliate and gives them the opportunity to progress to their respective National Development Camps.

The Boy's 2011 Youth Camps are scheduled for April 29 – May 1, 2011 (Birth Years 1996 & 1997) and May 5 – May 8, 2011 (Birth Years 1994 & 1995). Sixty-eight to eighty players in each of the four age groups will participate and compete during the four days of each camp. Approximately twenty players will be selected at each age group to represent the Pacific District at the USAH Player Development Camps.

The public is invited to drop by and observe camp activities. A detailed schedule of events is not available yet. However, the camp has scheduled on-ice activities on Friday from 9:15am to 5:45pm, Saturday from 8:00am to 7:45pm and Sunday from 8:00am to 12:45pm.

The 2011 Girls' Camp is scheduled for May 5 - 8, 2011 (Birth Years 1994 - 1995 - 1996 - 1997) at Olympic view Ice Arena, Mountlake Terrace, Washington.

Sprinker Ice Arena Closing May 17th for Remodel

Sprinker Ice Arena in Spanaway will shut down May 17th for a six-month, \$6.1 million overhaul. The 35-year-old facility is badly in need of repairs. Hockey and figure skating activities will move to Puget Sound Hockey Center in Tacoma. Public skating sessions are one of the casualties of the shut down. They will resume when the facility reopens.

The remodel will include:

- Renewing the skating facility with a new ice sheet and replacing the refrigeration and other equipment that maintains it.
- Replacing the roof and structural deck over the ice arena.

- Sealing the arena from the rest of the building so the rink's mechanical systems can handle the humidity from the ice and block it from other areas of the center.
- Other work, including remodeling restrooms, locker rooms, skate rental and visitor areas may be done if money permits.
