



## **Update on PeeWee Storm Spring League Play**

### **PeeWee Storm Win Two in Lower Mainland Spring League Play May 2nd**

**Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent, WA 13 May, 2010** – The Kent Valley PeeWee Storm came back from a two goal deficit in game 1 against the Port Moody Panthers to defeat the Panthers 3 to 2. The Panthers scored a goal in the first period and another in the second to blank the Storm in the first 32 minutes of play. Kent Valley's Tom Speer got the Storm into the game at 1:39 of the 3<sup>rd</sup> period. Speer's goal was assisted by Mason Conner and Elliot Plourde. Conner scored an unassisted and tying goal at 5:54. The Storm continued to pressure the Panthers and it paid off at 8:42 when Mikey Thomas scored the game winner with an assist from Elliot Plourde.

Kent Valley's Carson Zadina faced 31 shots on goal, turning away all but two for save percentage of 93.5%. The Storm fired 29 shots on the Panther's goal. Kent Valley had 2 penalties for 4 minutes while Port Moody had 7 penalties for 14 minutes.

**Game two:** Next up for the Storm was an afternoon match with the North Delta Rangers. Again, penalties got the best of the opposition. North Delta had 4 minor infractions while Kent Valley skated penalty free. It was a tight game in periods 1 and 3 as each team matched shots in both periods. The second period had all the scoring action with North Delta scoring the first goal of the game at 1:30 of the second period. Almost four minutes later, at 5:25, Dylan Moriarty scored the tying goal. Mason Conner got the game winner at 13:17 of the second period.

Kent Valley's Carson Zadina turned away 23 of 24 shots on goal for a save rate of 95.8% and another impressive performance in net. Kent Valley had 27 shots on goal. It was a good weekend for a Spring Storm.
