



KVHA News – Lorenz Names Wagner to Squirt "B" and Ferguson to PeeWee T-II

Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent, WA. May 14, 2015 – Kent Valley Hockey Association's Hockey Director, Danny Lorenz, announced Squirt "B" and PeeWee T-II Coaches for the 2015-2016 hockey season this week. Lorenz named Matt Wagner as Head Coach for KVHA's Squirt "B" team and Jeff Ferguson as Head Coach of KVHA's PeeWee Tier-II team.

Matt Wagner assisted with KVHA's Learn to Play program beginning with the 2010/2011 hockey season and first served as a coach with 2013/2014 Mite Lightning. Wagner assisted Coach Derek Pizzey with the Squirt Tornadoes during the 2014/2015. Matt played his minor hockey in the Cincinnati Amateur Hockey Association, the same one that Danny Lorenz was a part of before coming to KVHA. He played in the local Cascade B league in 1999 and moved to the Greater Seattle Hockey League (GSHL) as an adult in 2002. Matt has played for the GSHL Ghost Riders in division 3 and the Jets and Riders in division 1 over the last 13 years. He also played for the Wings and Bulldogs in Tacoma's division 1 and competed in a 3x3 league for 10 years. Over the years, Matt has organized 4-6 adult travel tournaments a year to destinations like Spokane, Vancouver, Las Vegas, Minnesota and Wisconsin.

Jeff Ferguson began his KVHA Coaching career in 2008/2009 with KVHA's Learn to Play program. He coached at the Mite level for the 2010/2011 and 2011/2012 seasons, Squirt level for the 2012/2013 season and PeeWee level for the 2013/2014 and 2014/2015 hockey seasons.

Ferguson grew up playing minor hockey through Midget and Juniors with Sno-King Amateur Hockey Association out of the Lynnwood ice rink. After juniors Jeff got heavily into refereeing Junior and adult league games while continuing to play in the top level of the Cascade Adult league. He founded a team in that league called the Seattle Storm (waaaay before any WNBA team STOLE the team's name). He coached PeeWee and Bantam at Sno-King for a couple years in his early 20's while refereeing and skating the adult leagues as well. He played in competitive adult leagues through most of his 20's until his career as a police officer dominated all of his time and he could no longer commit nights and weekends to hockey. Ferguson remained a big hockey fan all of his adult life (Go Pens!) until his son Jake was old enough to start learning to skate. *"I put Jake on skates when he was 3 years old and taught him to skate and handle a stick. We did a couple of stick and pucks together and he loved it, which rekindled my fire and passion for participating in the game myself. At that point I spoke with Danny Lorenz and jumped back into the game - this time as a coach!"*
