



KVHA Registration Deadline is June 1st.

Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent, WA. Thursday, May 19, 2016 - KVHA members are encouraged to register for the 2016-2017 hockey season prior to June 1st in order to avoid a rate increase. Early registration helps KVHA determine which teams they will offer and what coaching resources are needed for the new season. Ice fees for Rec and Tier-ii teams will increase 5% on June 1st.

KVHA's \$250 Registration Fee will be waived for multiple player registrations in the same family at the time of registration. Just as with the auction fees charged in prior years, it is not our intent to assess a family multiple registration fees when they have two or more players registered with KVHA.
