



Kent Valley's Head Coaching Assignments Nearly Complete, Pre-Registration is Strong

Kent, WA – KVHA News for 25 May, 2010 – Danny Lorenz, KVHA Hockey Director, reports that head coaching assignments for the 2010/2011 hockey season are nearly complete. Three spots remain to be filled, Squirt Rec Tornadoes, Bantam Rec Tornadoes and Bantam Tier-II Selects. Lorenz said Monday, *"The final three coaching assignments should be confirmed within the next week or so. We're very close."* Les Grauer added, *"Members requested we make our coaching announcements earlier than in years past. We've been able to speed up the process and confirm as many coaching assignments as possible. The process is more complicated than one might imagine. But, eleven of fourteen isn't bad. We're pleased."*

KVHA Early Registration is Stronger than Usual – Register Now, Rates go up June 1st

This is just a reminder that Kent Valley Hockey Association's (KVHA) June 1st early registration deadline is approaching fast. KVHA thanks all those who have already registered and would like to remind everyone else that registrations must be received by next Tuesday, June 1st in order to guarantee your spot and the early registration rates. After June 1st, there will be a 7% rate increase. Our projections show we will have more players and teams than our current schedule has the ability to accommodate. Registrations received after June 1st may be subject to a try-out format if the number of players for the allotted team exceeds the team player limits. Registrations received before June 1st will be guaranteed a spot on a roster.

New applicants to join KVHA are also eligible to begin registration on a first-come, first-serve, waiting list basis by submitting their paperwork and fees immediately. Waiting list applicants shall be admitted in the order received at the conclusion of returning member registration, June 1st, 2010.
