



KVHA News – Kent Valley’s Dylan Gambrell Headed to New York Islanders Mini Camp



Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent, WA. July 07, 2014 – Former Kent Valley standout Dylan Gambrell is among a group of 48 top prospects invited to the New York Islanders Top Prospects Mini Camp on July 8-12 at Nassau Coliseum. Gambrell enters the camp as an “undrafted free agent.”

Gambrell played for Kent Valley Hockey Association as Mite 2004/2005 through PeeWee 2008/2009. He was a member of the combined West Coast/Kent Valley PeeWee Elite team in 2008/2009. During his tenure with Kent Valley Gambrell held two

single-game scoring records:

Most goals in a single game. 6 – 11/30/2008 Dylan Gambrell, Kent Valley/West Coast PeeWee “AAA” 13 vs. Seattle Jr. PeeWee “AA” Admirals 0 at Wenatchee. Dylan Gambrell scored 2 goals in the first, 3 goals in the second and 1 goal in the third period.

Most points in a single game. 8 – 11/30/2008 Dylan Gambrell (6 goals & 2 assists), Kent Valley/West Coast PeeWee “AAA” 13 vs. Seattle Jr. PeeWee “AA” Admirals 0 at Wenatchee. Dylan Gambrell scored 2 goals in the first period, 3 goals in the second and 1 goal in the third period. Gambrell added 2 assists, both in the first period for a total of 8 points for the game.

The New York Islanders annual mini camp begins Tuesday, July 8 at Nassau Coliseum. Top prospects, including 2014 First-Round Picks Michael Dal Colle and Joshua Ho-Sang, will skate at the mini camp and participate in the annual Blue and White Scrimmage on Thursday July 10 at 7:00 p.m. Fans will have the opportunity to see the organization’s top prospects compete in an intra-squad game and see the players take part in a post-game skills competition. The night will conclude with an autograph session, open to all attendees.

Gambrell played for the **Dubuque Fighting Saints** of the United States Hockey League the past two seasons. He was fourth in scoring last season with 14 goals and 29 assists for 43 total points. He will play for the Saints again next season before moving on to Denver University. Prior to playing for the Dubuque Fighting Saints Gambrell played for the Colorado Thunderbirds U16 Tier 1, triple-A team.

Evan Sarthou Selected for 2014 Ivan Hlinka Memorial Cup Team.

Colorado Springs, Colorado. July 2, 2014 – Twenty-two players who participated at the USA Hockey Boys’ Select 17 Player Development Camp have been chosen for the U.S. Under-18 Select Team that will compete at the 2014 Ivan Hlinka Memorial Cup Aug. 11-16 in Breclav, Czech Republic, and Piestany, Slovakia. Among them is former Kent Valley Hockey Association goaltender Evan Sarthou. Sarthou played for Kent Valley 2004/2005 through 2008/2009. He currently plays for the Western Hockey League Tri-City Americans.

The Ivan Hlinka Memorial Cup is an annual event held each August for national under-18 teams from around the world. Named for one of the first Czech hockey stars, the tournament began in 1991 as a three-team showcase. Between 1997 and 2002, the format shifted to the current eight-team tournament. It was then named after Hlinka in 2007, three years after his passing.

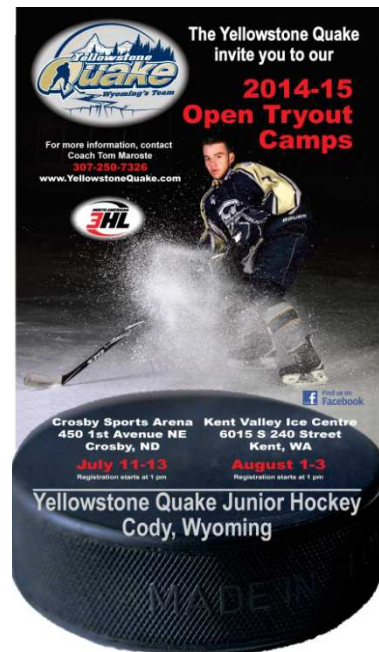
