KVHA News Items for August 21, 2008

Kent, WA. August 21, 2008 – It was a busy weekend at Kent Valley Ice Centre as more than seventy PeeWees, Bantams, Midgets and U-16/U-18 candidates took to the ice to try-out for spots on Kent Valley Hockey Association's (KVHA) rep teams. The Seattle Thunderbirds training camp gets underway Friday August 22nd at Kent Valley Ice Centre and runs through the middle of next week. News regarding this and other items are noted below.

T-Bird Practices Will Not Conflict With KVHA Practices

Kent Valley Ice Centre (KVIC) confirmed today that Seattle Thunderbird practices at KVIC will not adversely impact the ice time available for KVHA teams. Les Grauer, Director of Operations for KVIC said, "The T-Bird's weekday practices will occur during the early afternoon (2:15pm – 4:15pm) during a time slot the hockey program has never utilized. The T-Bird practice schedule will not conflict with or take anything away from KVHA teams." Grauer's comments followed concerns stated earlier by parents that the T-Birds might be taking practice ice away from KVHA teams. "That's simply not the case," Grauer said.

KVHA players are encouraged to drop by KVIC and watch the Seattle Thunderbirds practice whenever possible. Danny Lorenz, KVHA's Hockey Director, said, "It's a great opportunity for the young kids in our association who dream the dream of playing at a higher level, to watch the 16 to 20 year-old T-Bird players who are taking a step toward realizing their dream of skating at that higher level. If they're a Squirt or PeeWee, it could be them out there in 4, 5 or 6 years. Watching the T-Birds up-close and personal can inspire them to work hard on realizing their dreams."

The Seattle Thunderbird's annual training camp begins Friday August 22nd and runs through Wednesday August 27th. Again, KVHA members are invited to observe the training camp sessions. Ice times are posted on the schedules under the **Ice Schedules** tab at www.KentValleyHockey.com.

Additional Try-Outs Scheduled for Kent Valley Selects

Additional Try-Out Practices have been scheduled for PeeWee Tier-II, Bantam Tier-II, Midget Tier-II and U-16/U-18 teams. Essentially, this is a continuation of the Try-Outs from August 15th.

For those players who paid the initial Try-Out fee, no additional payment is necessary for participation in this round of try-outs. If a player was unable to participate in the original round of try-outs and did not pay the try-out fee, the drop-in rate is \$12.50 per session. The drop-in option is also available for players just wanting to get in some practice time but having no desire to try-out for a spot on a rep team. The schedule is as follows:
