### ***Kent Valley Bantam Tier-II Selects Test the Ice to the North in Weekend Play***

**Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent, WA 21 September, 2011** – The Kent Valley Bantam Selects began their season with three games in two days last weekend. The Selects played host to SnoKing on Saturday and Sunday at Kent Valley Ice Centre and travelled to Mission, B.C. for a Sunday evening game with a Mission Bantam "AA" team. The Selects defeated SnoKing on Saturday and tied them on Sunday. The Mission "AA" team matched the Selects point for point to gain a tie in the third period.

Notable in the games with SnoKing was the Selects’ high volume of shots-on-goal. Coach Pizzey’s boys tallied 39 shots in game one and 45 shots in game two.
