# Kent Valley 16U Rainiers Defeat Bellingham 16U Blazers 5 to 1 in Home Opener

September 27, 2014** – Kent Valley's 16U Tier-I Rainiers defeated the Bellingham 16U Blazers 5 to 1 in Kent Valley Ice Centre's first game of the 2014/2015 hockey season. The Rainiers led the Blazers 4 to 0 in the closing minutes of the final period when the Blazers' Nikita Kovalenko ruined a Rainiers' shutout with his power play goal with 3:17 remaining to play. Kovalenko was assisted by Caden Buttke. The Rainiers' Kyle Katras scored a power play goal with just 29 seconds remaining to bump the Rainiers' lead back to four goals.
