

KVHA News – KVHA Record Book in Deep Slumber Since January 2014, But, Credit Connor Kirby for Giving it a Wake Up Call.

Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent, WA. Thursday, October 8, 2015 – Connor Kirby, Kent Valley Squirt “B” Selects, had one heck of a game over the weekend. Connor scored four consecutive goals in one game Saturday as his Kent Valley Squirt “B” Selects defeated the SnoKing Squirt “B” Green team 9 to 5. Kirby’s four goals caught my eye while doing the game write-up for the KVHA News. I immediately checked the KVHA Record Book to see if Kirby had earned an entry. Connor scored his first goal at 2:30 of the second period with an assist from Jacob Beamish and his second at 5:11 of the second from Seth Banner. He earned his Hat Trick with an Unassisted Power Play goal at 9:33 of the second and scored his fourth and final goal at 7:48 of the third period with assists from Liam Heary and Tyson Walker on a Power Play. Wow!

Scoring four goals in one game is very rare indeed. Scoring them consecutively is even more rare. However, I regret to report that Connor Kirby fell several minutes short of the Fastest Four Goals in KVHA history. That record belongs to Kenneth Gill who scored four consecutive goals in 3 minutes and 10 seconds on November 15, 2008. Kirby’s four goals spanned a period of over 17 minutes, a long way from Gill’s record. Dang it!

Oh! By the way, did I mention that Kirby’s teammate Ripken Renner also had a terrific game? While Kirby was scoring his four consecutive goals, Renner scored a Hat Trick of his own, two in the first period as well as the final goal of the game. You might say it was a great day for Coach Matt Wagner’s Squirt “B” Selects. Way to go Kent Valley!

Kent Valley is Participating in Torklift Central's 5th Annual Kent Turkey Challenge

Kent businesses are competing to collect the most food and monetary donations for the Kent Food Bank. The goal this year is 10,000 lbs of food and \$25,000 in cash. Last year, the Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent Valley Figure Skating Club and Kent Valley Hockey Association staff and members combined to donate 693 pounds of canned and boxed food items and some cash. Kent Valley's food contribution of 693 pounds was fourth behind Seattle/Tacoma KOA at 2,830 pounds, Ski's Painting Inc. at 2,755 pounds, and Springbrook Elementary at 1,873 pounds.

Torklift Central of Kent organizes the Annual Kent Turkey Challenge for the Kent Food Bank. Katie Brown, Marketing Director, for Torklift Central said, *"By working together we will be able to spread goodwill throughout our community and feed roughly 2,000 families that may not otherwise have a Thanksgiving dinner. The Kent Food Bank will be the recipient of all money and canned goods collected during this challenge. Thank you so much for participating in this event. Together we can truly do something amazing and create a tradition in our community! Let's work together because we can accomplish so much more united."*

Lew Sellers, KVHA President, represented KVHA, KVIC and KVFSC at a December 2014 Kent City Council meeting and accepted fourth place honors for food collection. In receiving the award last year Sellers told Council members, *"We basically won this fourth place honor without trying very hard. In 2015 we will be better prepared to participate, promote the Turkey Challenge more and we will do our best to be number one."*
