

KVHA News – Kent Valley’s Lexi Doner Celebrates 35th Anniversary of National Championship

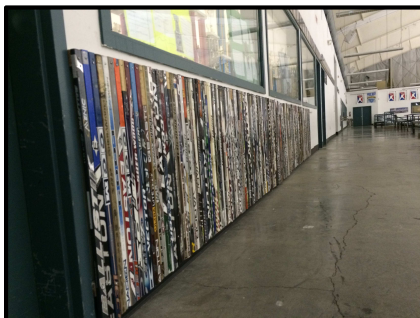
