



KVHA News – KVHA Record Book Assault Continues as Ripken Renner Scores Four Goals in One Period.

Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent, WA. Friday, December 18, 2015 – Kent Valley's Ripken Renner, Squirt "B" Selects, tied the KVHA record for **Most Goals in One Period** (4) at the 2015 SAYHA Winterfest Squirt "B" Tournament in Spokane on Sunday, December 6th. Renner scored all four goals in the third period of the game. However, he missed setting a new record for the fastest four goals by several minutes.

The third period seems to be Ripken Renner's favorite period this season. In a game at Kent Valley Ice Centre on December 13th, Renner scored two consecutive goals in the third period with the final goal being scored at 12:59. The KVHA Record Book will now include Ripken Renner for scoring the Latest Goal to End a Game and a Period. Renner's goal may have actually been scored at 0:00:03 (according to spectators), giving less than one second remaining. However, the score sheet (backup documentation for establishing records) shows the goal being scored at 12:59 or 0:01 (it was 13:00 period.) Renner will share the record with several others. Here are the details from the record :

Most Goals in One Period: 4 - Ripken Renner – 12/06/2015, will join Caleb Chaloner – 11/23/2013, Anton Nikitin – 11/14/2010 and Kenneth Gill – 11/15/2008 in the KVHA Record Book.

Latest Goal to End a Game: 0:01 Second – Ripken Renner 12/13/2015, will join Tom Speer 11/27/2010 and Alex Soldano 02/13/2005 in the KVHA Record Book.

Latest goal to End a Period: 0:01 Second – Ripken Renner 12/13/2015, will join Tom Speer 11/27/2010, Molly Doner 01/13/2008 and Anthony Puntel 12/04/2004 in the KVHA Record Book.

Kent Valley Ice Centre, Kent, WA. December 12, 2015 – It only took the Kent Valley Squirt Tornados one period and 5:59 into the second period to defeat the Everett Squirt Grizzlies. Jonas Nelson scored the game winner with an assist from Stormy Carolus. Nelson went on to earn a Hat Trick with two more goals in the final period.

Clayton Carolus score in the opening minute of the game to give the Tornados the early lead.
